

WAGGIN' TAILS OFF-LEASH DOG PARK RULES & REGULATIONS

HOURS OF OPERATION

Sunrise to Sunset

DOG OFF-LEASH AREA RULES FOR USE (VIOLATIONS MAY RESULT IN CITATIONS AND FINES)

- Dogs may only be allowed off leash while within the designated boundaries of Waggin' Tails Off-Leash Dog Park.
- 😵 No dog shall be allowed into the off-leash area if said dog is known to have bitten any person or animal at any time.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The following Code of Conduct for the Waggin' Tails Off-Leash Dog Park has been established to provide for the safety of park patrons and their pets, as well as for the protection of park resources.

DOG OWNERS

- Are responsible for any and all injuries or damage caused by their dog(s).
- Are limited to a maximum of three dogs per visit, two dogs preferred, & must be under owner's control.
- Are required to pick-up and dispose of their dog's waste in the collection containers provided to help reduce the potential spread of parasites.
- Must leash and remove their dogs(s) from the off-leash area at the first sign of aggressive behavior.
- Are responsible to see that their dog(s) are healthy, current with all veterinarian recommended vaccinations and have proof of a current rabies vaccination. (May be required upon request.) Tags may serve as proof.
- Must closely supervise their dog(s) and have them in view at all times. Please limit cell phone use.
- Must have leashes readily available at all times.
- Must not bring food, dog treats, glass or alcohol into the off-leash area.
- Must not allow children under the age of 16 within the boundaries of the off-leash area unless accompanied by an adult.
- Must closely monitor non-neutered male dogs.
- Smoking is prohibited in the off-leash area.
- Dogs over 25 lbs. are not allowed in the small dog area.

DOGS

- May NOT wear pronged, spiked or choke collars within the off-leash area.
- Under the age of 12 weeks of age are not allowed in the area.
- Dogs in heat are not allowed anywhere in the park area.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

All those entering the designated off-leash area, are aware that the dogs are un-leashed and loose. Despite the best efforts of any dog owner/handler, a dog may act in an unpredictable manner. Dog owners/handlers are entirely responsible for their dog's actions and accept the risk of allowing their dog(s) to interact with people, other dogs, employees and their vehicles in the performance of their duties. Owners are legally responsible for any injury caused by their dog(s).
